
How to use – Immersive Reader


1. Locate the Immersive Reader

The Immersive Reader button is in the upper right of the screen. Click the button to activate it.




2. Main Immersive Reader screen


On the main screen, the text from the related Canvas assignment or other document will be displayed here. There are five main elements to be aware of. There is the Play and Pause button, highlighted on this screen.




Next to that is the Voice settings button. Click this button.




In the Voice Settings interface window, you can choose the speed and type of voice.




In the upper right corner, there are three more user interface areas to help customize your usage of Immersive Reader. The first is the Text Preferences button – go ahead and click it.




In the Text Preferences interface window, you can change the size, spacing, font, and theme.




The middle button is for Grammar Options.




In the Grammar Options interface window, you can toggle the breaking up of syllables, and if certain parts of speech are highlighted, with custom color selections for each.



The last button is where you can change the Reading Preferences.



On the Reading Preferences interface window, you can toggle line focus and the Picture Dictionary, and whether you want translation turned on with language choice.



Try out each of these settings if you want. You may find that one or more adjustments transforms your reading experience!
