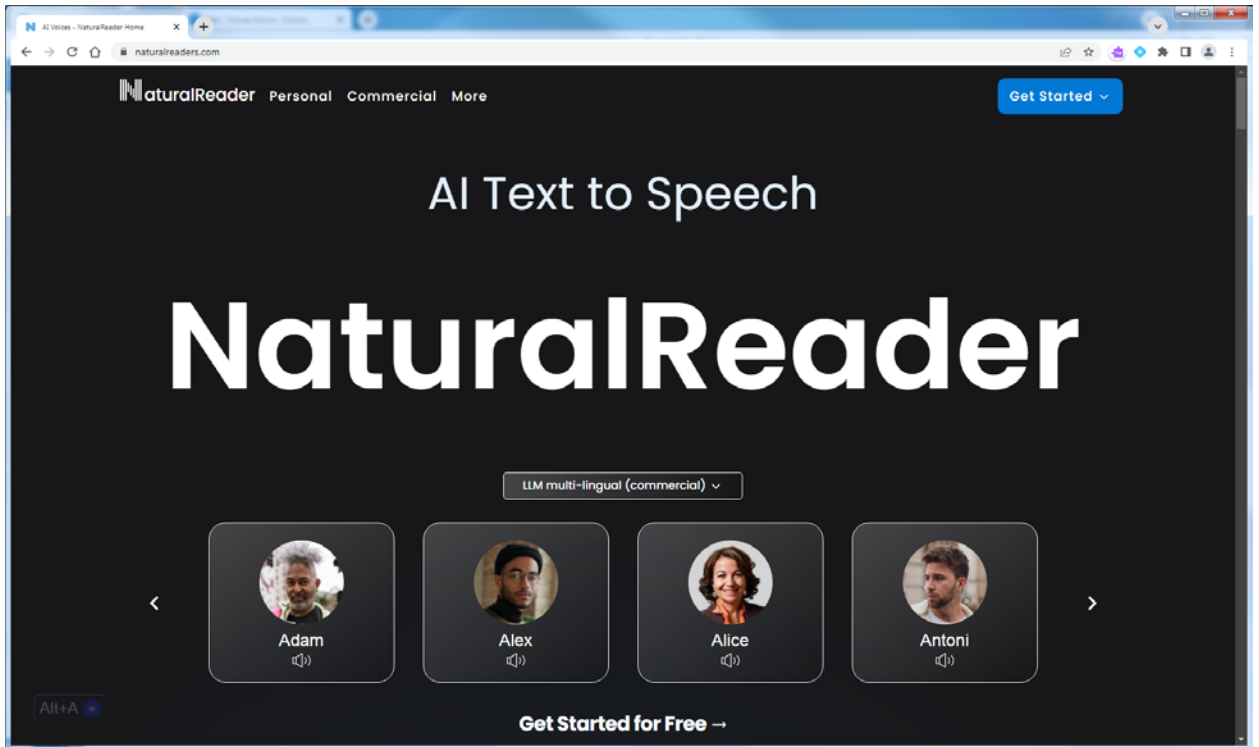
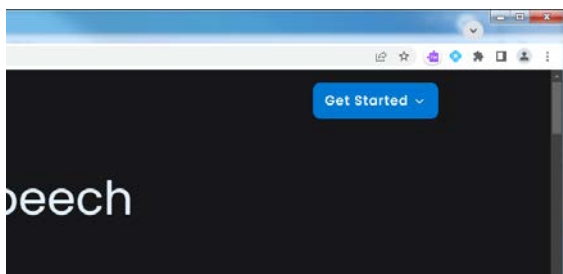


How to use Natural Reader

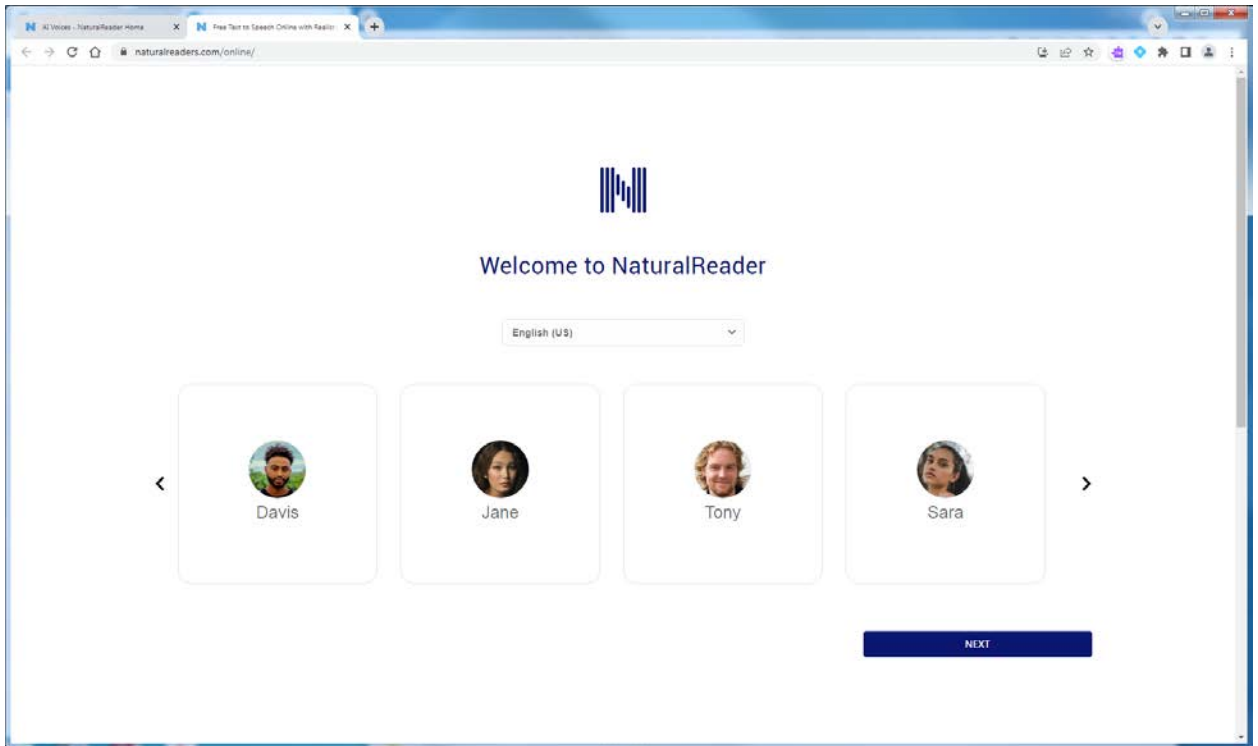
1. Open Natural Reader - Go to naturalreaders.com



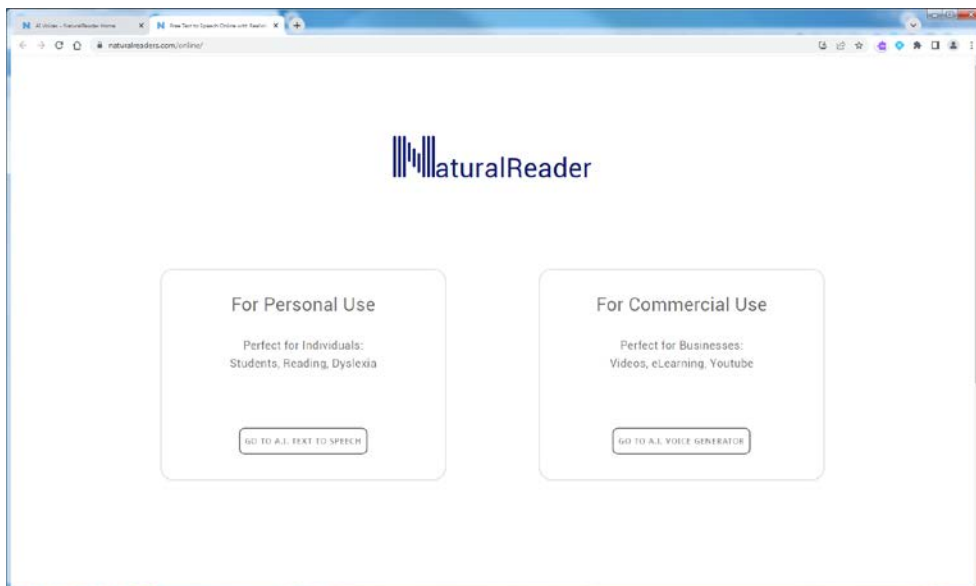
2. Click the “Get Started” button in the upper right corner – choose “Personal” from the list.



3. Click the “Next” button on the following screen:

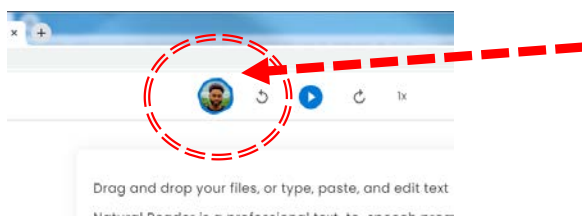
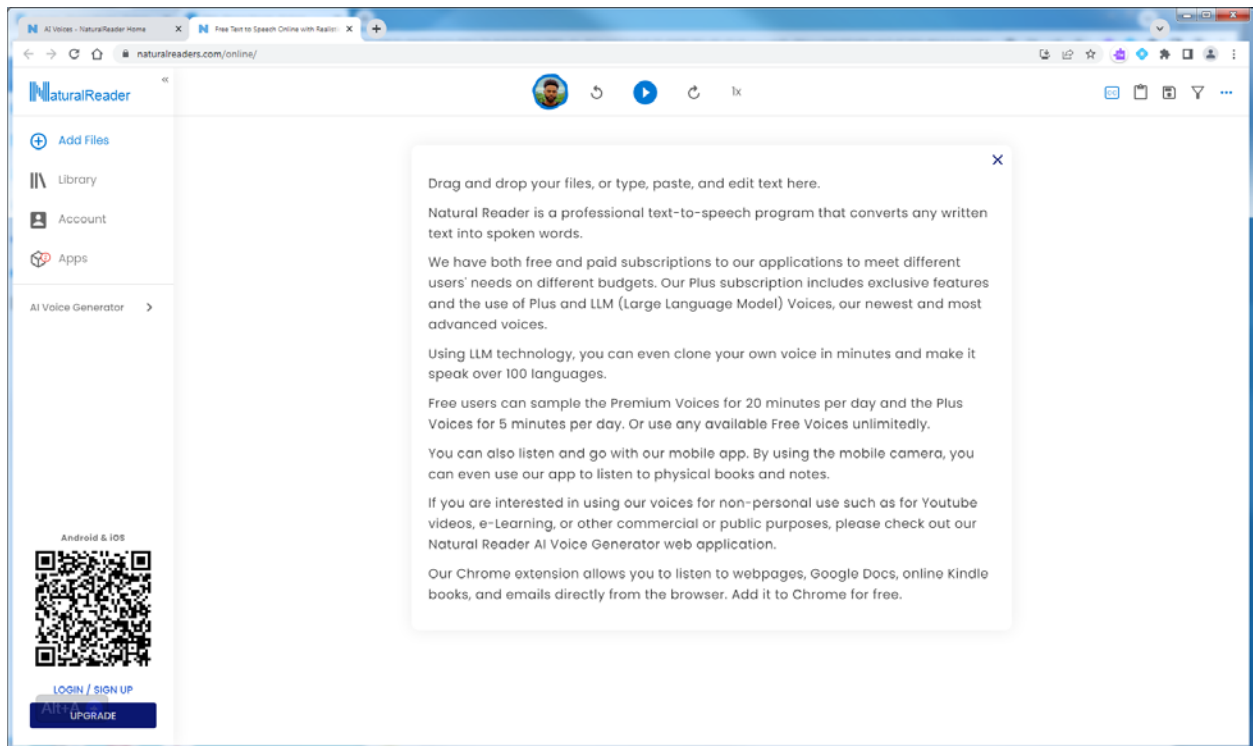


4. Click “For Personal Use” on the next screen:



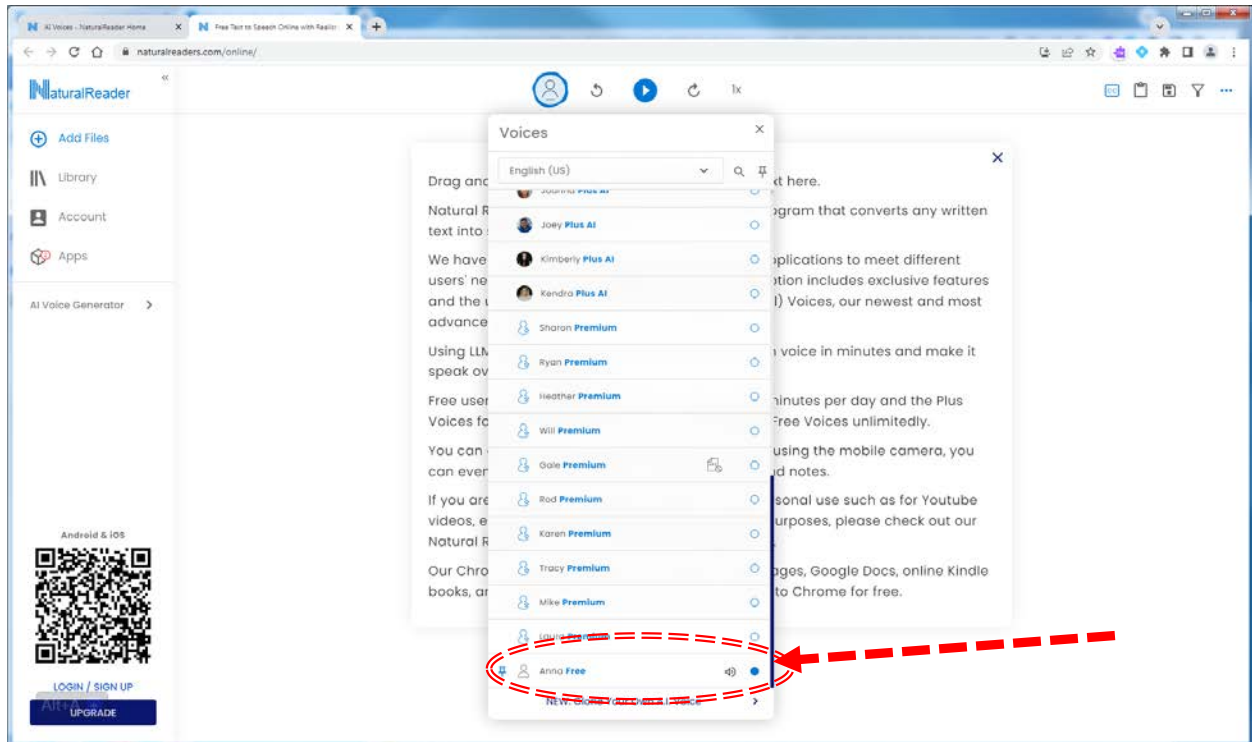
5. This is the standard ‘splash screen’

This is what you’ll see every time you log into Natural Readers. Click the “Voices” button towards the upper middle of the screen:



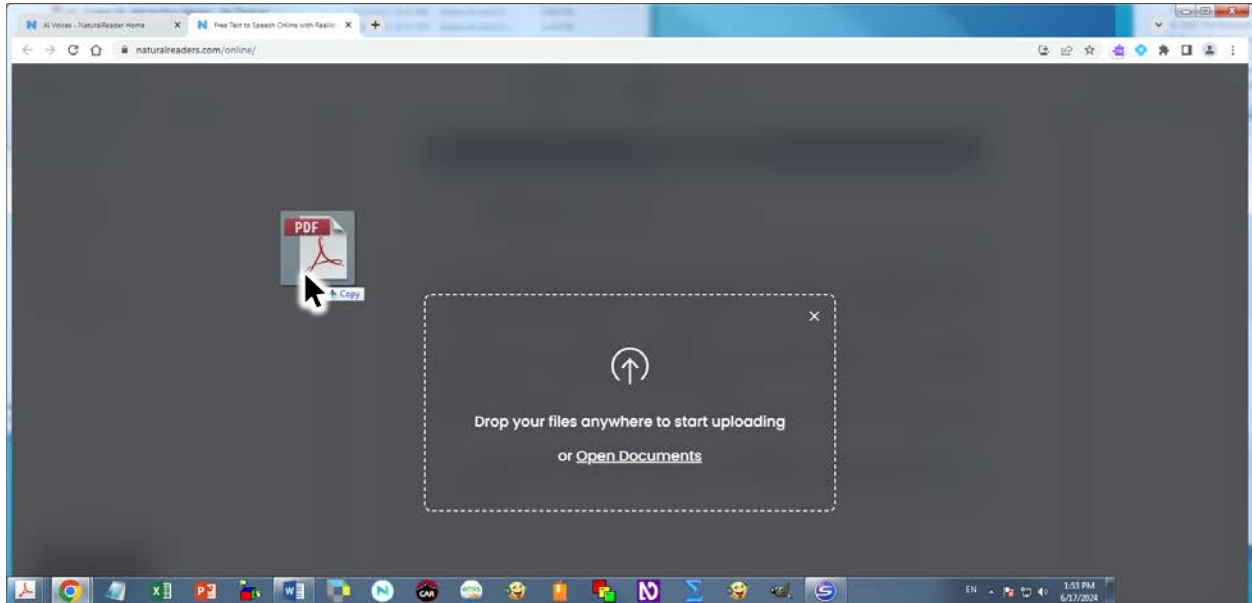
6. Voices

Note (from the splash screen wording), free users can sample the Premium Voices for 20 minutes per day and the Plus Voices for 5 minutes per day. Or use any available Free Voices unlimitedly. Choose “Anna free” at the bottom of the voices list to choose a free voice.



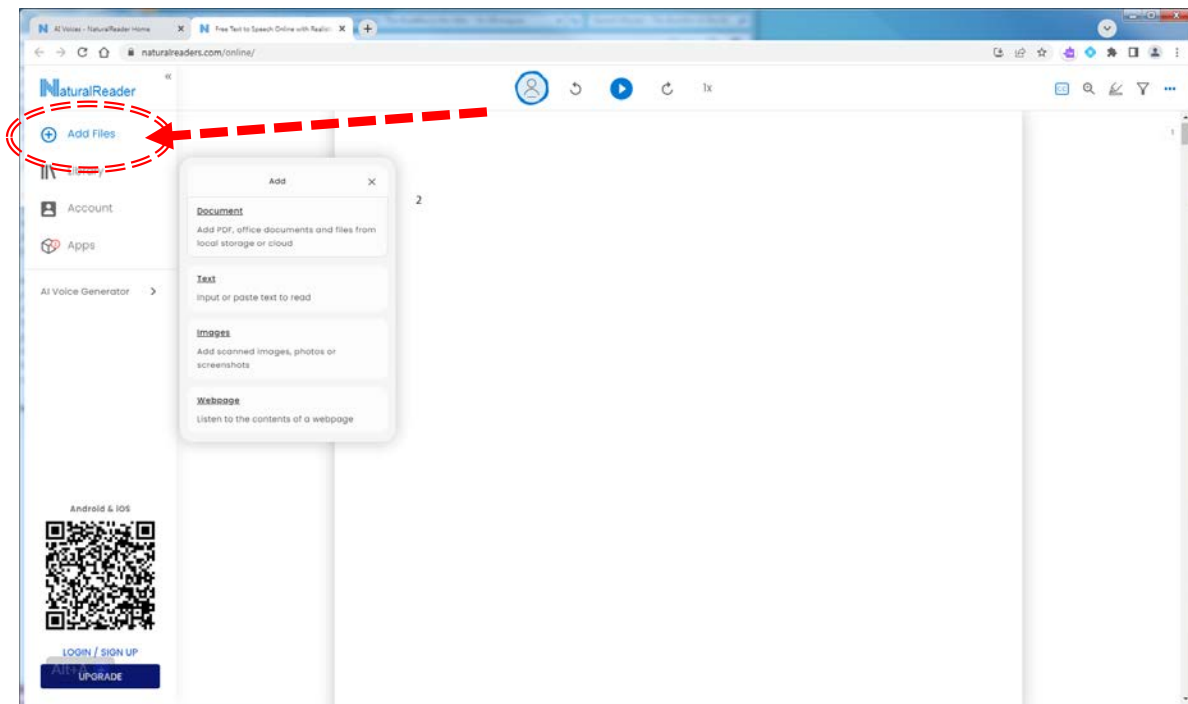
7. To use the software

(Also from the splash screen), drag and drop your files, or type, paste, and edit text. Dragging and dropping means taking a file from a folder on your computer and dropping it onto the splash screen.



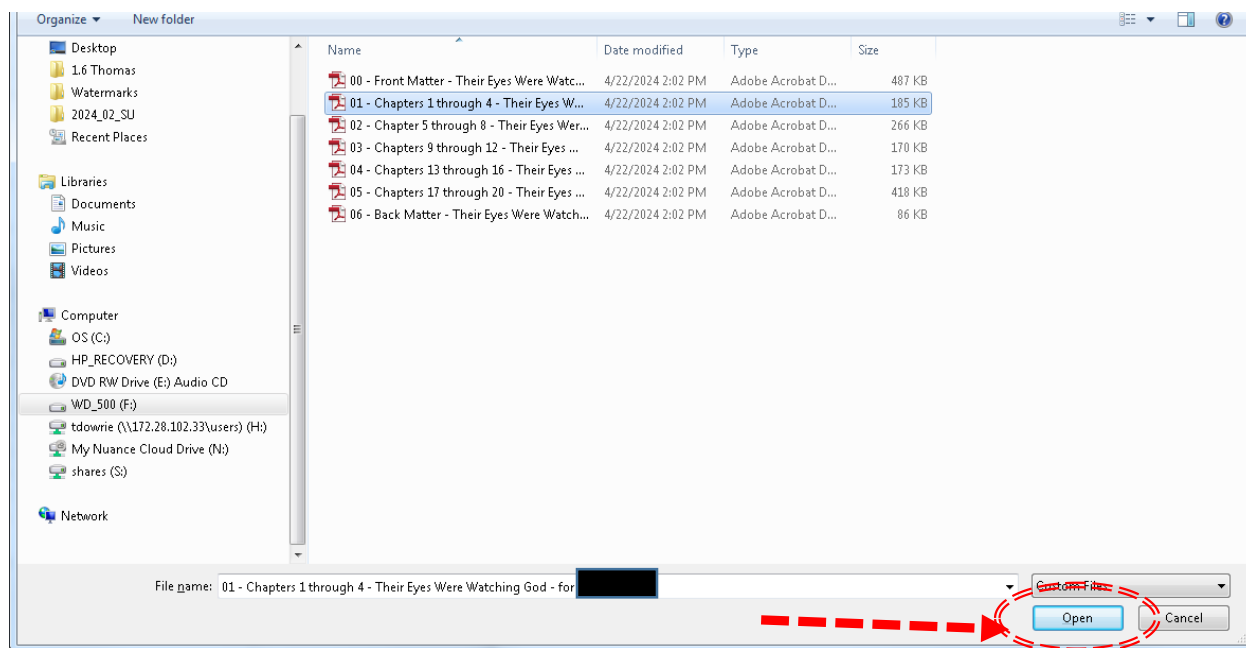
8. “Add Files” method.

You can also click “Add Files” in the upper left corner. The “Add” popup will appear. From here, you can select “Document” if opening a PDF or Word (.doc) file.



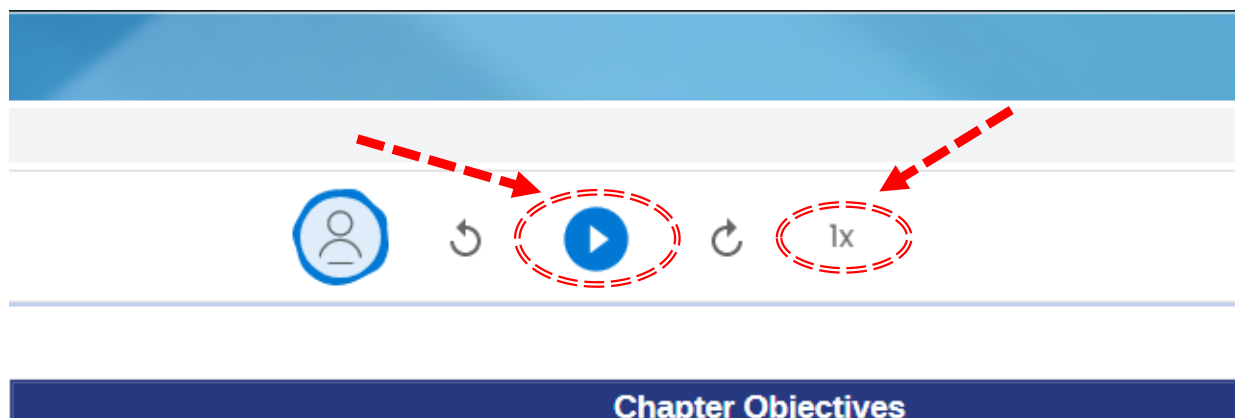
9. Locate file.

Navigate to the directory (like Desktop, Downloads, Documents, etc) where your file is located. Choose the file, and click “Open.”

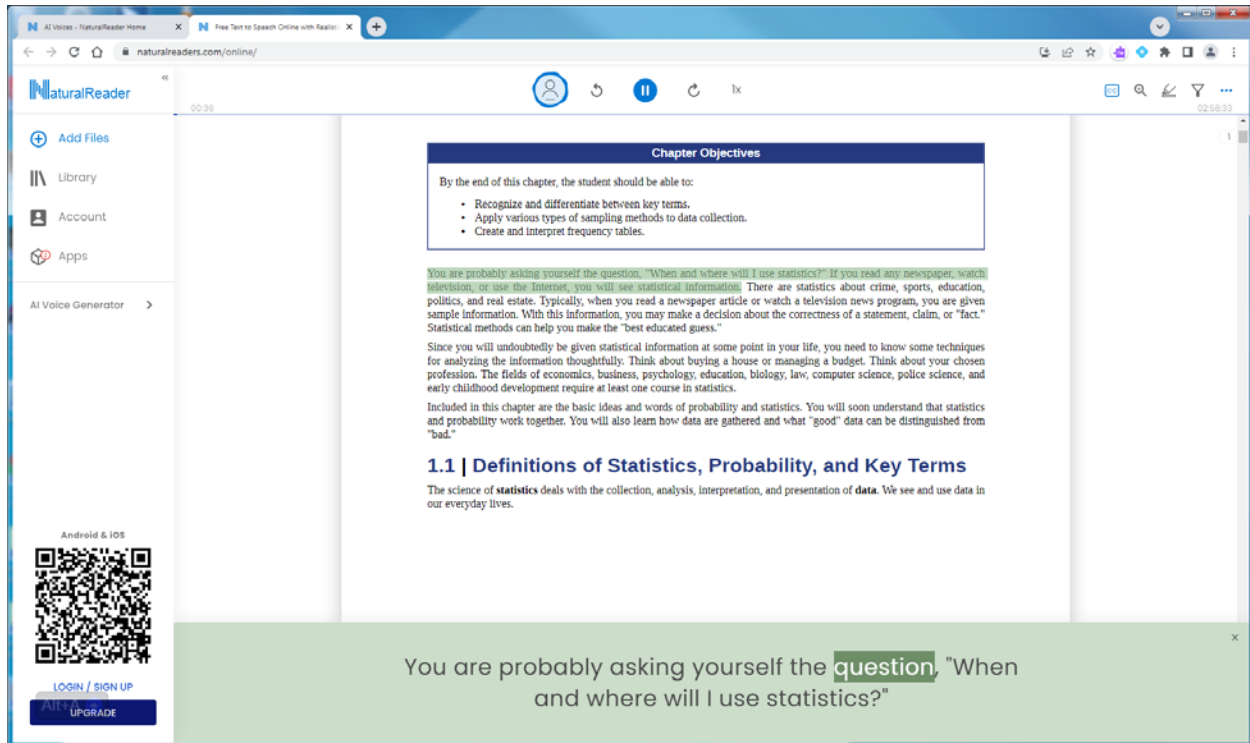


10. Begin reading your document

Click the “Play” button at the top of the screen in the middle. The text will begin reading to you. Note that it will be highlighted in the main body of the text as well as captioned in a larger font at the bottom of the screen. Click the “Pause” button (turns to Pause while playing) to stop the text being read. You may also use the Space Bar key on your keyboard to start / stop play. Use the “speed” button to change the speed of play.

11.Account creation.

Eventually, Natural Reader will ask you to create an account. ***You do not have to do this – nor do you have to pay for anything.*** You can keep using Natural Reader without creating an account. And you do NOT have to associate Google with your account either, you can use any email address, etc. However, creating an account will do two things for you:

- A. It will make the pop up go away – yay!
- B. It will synchronize your files across all devices by keeping them in your “Library.” Open a file from one device – continue reading from another.
